- **EARLY REGISTRATION \$25 DISCOUNT**– Register by May 15th and pay in full for one week-long session to qualify.
- **\$25 BUDDY DISCOUNT** – Registration and payment must be sent together. Campers must attend the same session to qualify.
- **\$25 SIBLING DISCOUNT** – Per child per week-long session. More than one child attending a week-long session. Campers returning for a second week of camp are also eligible.

Discounts do not apply to Leadership Training, Lifeguard Training, or Beginners Camp.

Other Payment Notes:

- Avoid late fees of \$25 by registering at least 2 weeks before camp sessions begin.
- **FULL PAYMENT** is due 14 days before the beginning of the camp session
- Scholarships are available. Please contact the office at office@vpccministries.org or 315-314-7460.

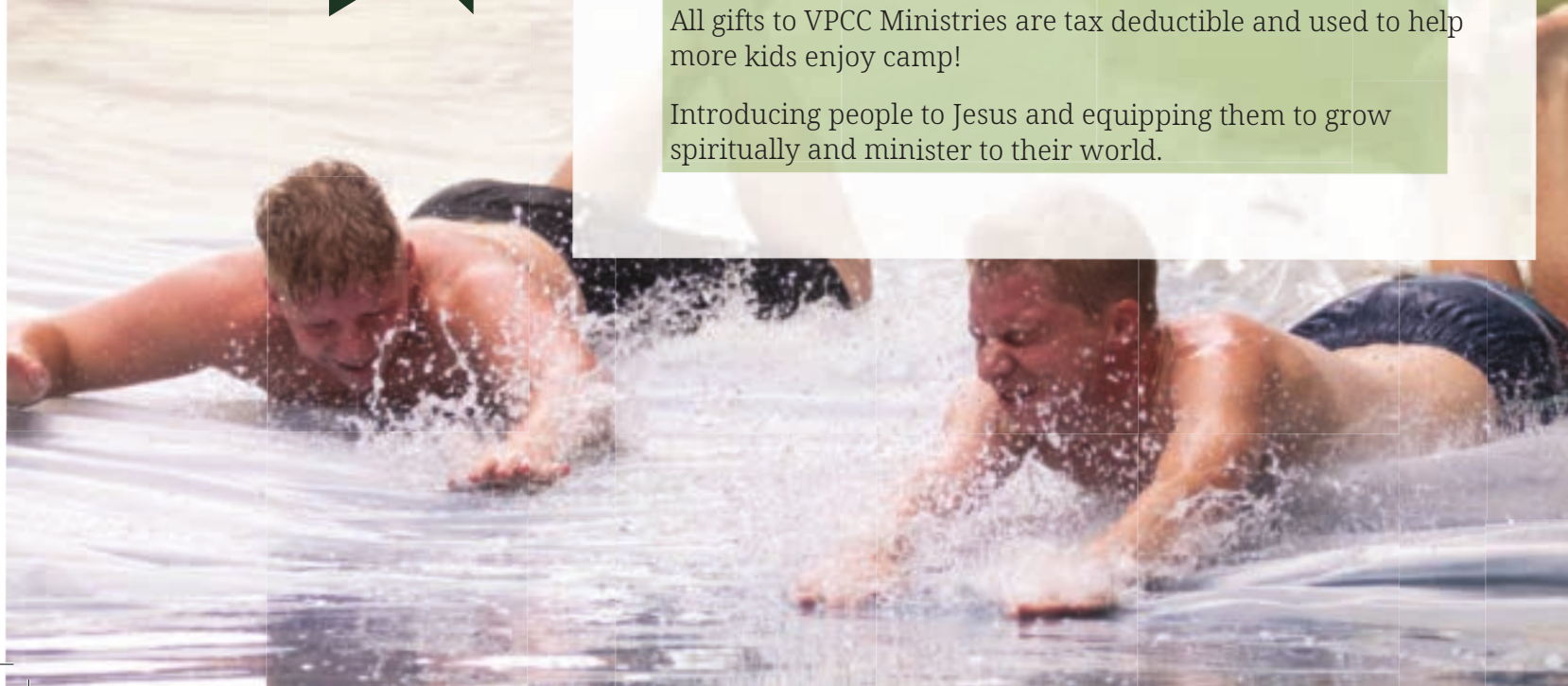
SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

FRONTIER BOYS: Held at our Frontier Facility, this adventure camp exposes boys to the “real” outdoors. Without electricity or shower houses, campers learn to survive in the wilderness; exploring building fires, cooking basic meals, practicing boating and canoeing techniques, and learning first aid basics.

FRONTIER GIRLS: This session, held at our “new” Frontier Facility, is just for girls! In the “real outdoors,” campers enjoy the wilderness while building fires, cooking basic meals, boating and canoeing, and learning first aid basics. There may even be some challenges vs. the boys from across the lake.

RUN FOR YOUR LIFE: This new session will include calisthenics and stretching in the morning. The routine will include a daily run exploring the Camp Vick trails, as well as some other exercises to get our physical bodies into shape. Campers will also learn how to “run” through several spiritual practices to grow and mature spiritually.

BEGINNERS: This unique over-night camping experience is designed to give younger campers a positive camping experience in a supportive Christian environment. The shortened session gives first-time campers a good introduction to the camping experience. They will have fun in the pool, play games, explore nature, and sing around a campfire. Intentionally smaller group size makes this a very safe and positive experience. Registration discounts do not apply to this session.

ADIRONDACK CANOE

CAMP: This is a seven-day trip through one of five wilderness areas of the Adirondack Mountains’ rivers and lakes. The trip will place the participants in out-back areas away from civilization. Everyone pitches in to cook, clean up, and learn how to camp with a leave-no-trace mind set. Campers need to be able to paddle and carry a canoe with a partner. We will be camping out in tents and spending our days paddling in lakes and rivers. Reasonable swimming skills are necessary. The trip is led by John Buskey and Alison Liedkie. Alison is an alumna of previous Adirondack trips. She has been a rafting guide and is trained in wilderness skills. Tents, canoes, life jackets and paddles are provided! Participants need a backpack suitable for a week of camping and a sleeping bag. Contact VPCC if this is an issue. Four registrations before June 1 are required in order to schedule our expert leader. The trip is limited to 9 participants to meet Adirondack Park restrictions.

MISSION POSSIBLE: Are you ready for a challenge? Spend a week at camp in an epic battle of wits, strength, and courage. Participate in a week-long mission with your team, as we solve clues, participate in group and individual challenges, and have a BLAST! The week includes a day trip to KINGDOM BOUND at Darien Lake Amusement Park!

INVESTIGATES: There is a mystery to solve at Camp Vick. Come help us solve the Great Camp Caper, as we explore and have fun finding clues and working as a team. Use your deductive skills and inquiring mind to crack the codes, solve the mystery, and find the culprit(s).

SPLASH CAMP: Just as the name implies, everything we’ll do involves water in some way. Just how many activities can we invent that will require water? Games in the pool! Games in the lake! Games on the land! Come and join us during one of the most popular weeks at Camp Vick!

SURVIVING FRONTIER: Can you be the Ultimate Survivor? Compete as part of a team in daily challenges and reward competitions; build your own fires, cook your own meals, and enjoy this unique Frontier Survivor program! Each night you will gather together for a torch ceremony on your quest to learn what it takes to be the Ultimate Survivor.

CAMPGROUND

Open May 15 through October 14.

WATERFRONT

Staff lifeguards (when available) are \$100 per day for up to 20 people. Add \$10 for each additional person. This includes a combined time of 3 hours of lifeguarding for waterfront and boating. Additional time is \$5 per person per hour (minimum \$20/hour).

FAMILY CAMP

Open Mid-May through Labor Day. Weekend only after Labor Day. Closing Columbus Day weekend. Camping starts at 3 pm and ends at 6pm, unless otherwise noted.
